## 1. Research and Instruction

- As of December 2022, I had 69 student, faculty, and staff consultations during the 2022 year. These include 27 undergraduate consultations, 29 graduate, 10 faculty or staff consultations and 3 public patron consultations.
- Held 61 consultations in 2021-2022, 78 consultations in 2020-2021, 53 consultations in 2019- 2020; 58 consultations in 2018- 2019; 67 consultations in 2017- 2018; 39 consultations in 2016- 2017.

- Since 2016, I have taught or co-taught 150 instructional sessions either in-person or virtually. These sessions include instructor-requested one-shots, dual-enrollment, and various class workshops.
- Continued teaching Systematic Review workshops for graduate students and faculty and expanded workshops offering protocol creation and exploring other reviews.
- Since 2020 held 27 evidence synthesis consultations with faculty and graduate students working on scoping reviews, systematic reviews, rapid reviews and traditional literature reviews.
- Collaborated with Nicollette Davis to host a workshop for graduate students to refresh their research skills. We discussed advance search terms, how to navigate the databases, and how to make appointments with liaisons.
- NFS 4021 Research Guide is a top five most used guide on the LSU Libraries with 46,156 views since its creation and 20,756 views in 2022 alone.
- My video, "<u>How to tell an original research article from a review article</u>" on the LSU Libraries YouTube channel has 8.3K views and is the most popular video on the channel.

#### 2. Liaison/Outreach/Programming

- Served as liaison to the departments of the College of Agriculture, College of Coast and Environment and Geology and Geophysics. Those departments include, Ag Economics & Agribusiness, Agricultural Extension, Education, and Evaluation, Animal Science, Entomology, Environment Science, Nutrition Food Science, Oceanography & Coastal Science, Plant, Environment & Soil Science, Plant Pathology & Crop Physiology, Renewable Natural Resources, and Textiles, Apparel Design, & Merchandising working with faculty, staff, and students in those departments.
- Participated in various College of Ag events including agriculture orientations for undergraduates and graduate students, Faculty Meetings, Burger Bash, Ag Center Field Days, and AgMagic.
- Chaired Libraries Programming Committee. Planned, organized, and facilitated leisure events for exam weeks. In 2022, we had a shift in our committee and introduced new people to our committee. We continue to work on building back up to our precovid numbers. Since January 2016, I have facilitated or participated in over 100 library outreach events.
- Co-Chair alongside Allen LeBlanc, the LSU Libraries Open House committee since 2019. Planned organized and facilitated the LSU Libraries Open House a large scale, multiple department event that showcases the Libraries services for

students.

- 2022: Hosted our 2022 Open House over two days with 387 students attending over two days.
- 2021: Worked alongside Danielle Costello to implement the second annual 2021 Digital Escape Room that ran congruently with the annual LSU Library Open House. 52 students participated in the event.
- 2021: Worked to revamp our LSU Libraries Open House Event. We moved the event outside, reimagined the design, and planned the event over two days. We connected with 392 students total.
- 2020: worked with the Programming Committee to create a virtual escape room that served in the place of a physical escape room. It was overwhelmingly a huge success with almost 500 virtual participants.
- 2019: Co-Chaired with Allen LeBlanc, the LSU Libraries Open House Committee.
- 2018: Co-Chaired with Sarah Simms, the LSU Libraries Open House Committee.
- Since 2016, I have collaborated with numerous partners on campus and off such as Center for Academic Success, First Year Experience, Student Union, Office of Multicultural Affairs, LSU Women's Center, LSU Police Department, Student Health, NAACP, Student Government, Panhellenic Council, GeauxVote, and East Baton Rouge Parish Library. Procrastination to assist students with papers and research project.
